Poll Book for Berkshire, 1818

Introduction

This CD presents a transcript of the poll book identifying the voters for the 'Knights of the Shires' in the General Election of 1818.

'Knights of the Shires' is a term applied to the Members of Parliament who sat for the County of Berkshire as opposed to those members representing boroughs or other places privileged to select their own MPs. In Berkshire there were two MPs for the Shire; two each for Windsor, Reading and Wallingford and one for Abingdon. The elections in the boroughs are not detailed in this poll book, although many residents of the above boroughs were entitled to vote for the Shire MPs and hence are listed.

This is not a list of those entitled to vote, but a list of those who did vote. It includes details of who voted for whom - there was no secret ballot in those days.

1818

The year in which this election took place was relatively uneventful, the previous Berkshire election contests took place in 1796 and 1812 when Britain was at war with revolutionary or Napoleonic France. In 1818 there was little to distract the electorate from local and national issues.

Births in 1818 included Emily Brontë and Karl Marx; in March, Mary Shelley's Frankenstein was published; in October, Felix Mendelssohn performed his first public concert at the age of nine; and, in December, Franz Xaver Gruber composed *Stille Nacht* or *Silent Night*.

The Election

Who could vote?

Voting rights in the Shire or County elections was limited to freeholders; consequently the electorate was small. Voters could vote for more than one candidate. In the Berkshire election two members were elected to parliament so each elector could, if they wished, choose two of the available candidates. Of course, voters could also qualify to vote again in one of the boroughs.

To Poll, or not to Poll?

In contrast to modern elections, the call to vote was in fact a rarity. In most elections the candidates or their 'parties' decided in advance who was to represent which area and ensured that the number of candidates matched the seats available, doing away with the need for an election. This was very obviously not democracy as we know it. However, the cost of elections was borne by the candidates and their supporters; if an MP had to defend his seat at every general election, it could quickly lead to bankruptcy.

There were occasions when the *status quo* was challenged and a vote was required. This became ever more likely as the fervour for political reform grew in the early 19th century resulting in the Great Reform Act of 1832.

The Candidates

The dominant political figure in Berkshire during this period was **Charles Dundas** of Barton Court, Kintbury; he represented the Shire as an MP from 1794 to 1832. Prior to this he sat as MP for the borough of Richmond (1774) and for Orkney and Shetland (1781-4). Although he was returned to Parliament from Berkshire no less than 10 times, he only had to fight elections in 1796, 1812, 1818 and 1820. He was originally adopted as member for Berkshire in 1794 to replace Winchcombe Henry Hartley (a descendent of Jack of Newbury) who had died in office; there was no by-election needed. By 1832 he was an old man and he accepted a peerage as 'Baron Amesbury of Kintbury, Amesbury and Barton Court, in the County of Berks, and of Aston Hall, in the County of Flint'. On his formal introduction to the House of Lords he was presented by Baron Braybrooke. Dundas was very active in the west of Berkshire and was pivotal in the development of the Speenhamland system of poor relief, but is chiefly remembered for his part in the development of the Kennet and Avon canal linking Newbury to Bath. A tunnel and aqueduct on this canal both bear his name.


The second candidate was **Richard Neville**. Born at Stanlake in the parish of Hurst, he succeeded to the title of Baron Braybrooke in 1825 and later presented the new Baron Amesbury to the House of Lords. At the time of the election the family seat was at Billingbear Park near Wokingham he later inherited Audley End in Essex and moved there. He is mainly remembered for his role as editor of the first publication of Samuel Pepys' 'Diary' in 1825. He

stood for Berkshire for the first time in 1812 replacing George Vansittart with whom Dundas had been 'elected' without a poll at the previous three general elections. He had previously served as a member for Thirsk (1805-6), Saltash (1807) and Buckingham (1807-12). He served as MP until his elevation to the peerage in 1825.

Standing against Dundas and Neville was a third candidate. William Hallett was a reform Hallett. candidate standing, for the second time, in support of the expansion of the electorate and the removal of the grossly undemocratic rotten boroughs. Hallett was from Faringdon in the north of the county but had built, in 1810, a house at Denford; very close to Dundas' Barton Court. He is also remembered, together with his wife, as the subject of Gainsborough's painting 'A Morning Walk', now in the collection of the National Gallery, London.

Political Parties

The main political groupings of the day were the Tories and the Whigs, these were not political parties as we understand the term today. Very

broadly speaking they grew out of the supporters of the Stuart succession (Tories) and those supporting the Hanoverian succession (Whigs). By 1818 this distinction was no longer a real

issue and members were far more independent than today, or seemingly so. Modern party organisation had yet to emerge and the government of the day would be formed out of a coalition of members with common interests; these tended to be predominately Tory or Whig, but there are many instances of senior figures featuring in successive governments of differing hue. However, despite their freedom from a party whip MPs were often appointed to parliament by the owner of a rotten borough and were there to serve their patron's interests.

Party alliance had little or nothing to do with the election in Berkshire; the issue was Parliamentary reform (Hallett) versus the status quo (Dundas & Neville). If elected Hallett would have allied himself with anyone promoting reform and would have voted as he saw fit on any other issue. All three candidates were wealthy Berkshire landowners, who would have made common cause in many instances, most importantly all candidates supposedly stood as independents whatever their loyalties to patron or political grouping. Loosely speaking Dundas can be viewed as the man chosen by the great and the good of west Berkshire, while Neville is his counterpart for the east of the county.

Patronage

In Berkshire the boroughs of Wallingford and New Windsor were in the pockets of rich patrons. In his book 'An entire and complete history, political and personal, of the boroughs of Great Britain' in 1792, Thomas Oldfield declined to name the patron at Windsor:

"The patron of this borough cannot with propriety be named, lest we might incur the rebuke of royalty."

He was less constrained when discussing Wallingford:

"Although this borough is not under the immediate influence of any nobleman or opulent commoner. The highest bidder is always chosen. No other influence is known to prevail there, except that of the nabob, Sir Francis Sykes."

Abingdon and Reading had, as Oldfield put it, "not yet been subjected to the arbitrary influence of any opulent individual."

Regarding the shire Oldfield writes:

"The interest of Lord Craven has generally sufficient weight to influence the election of one representative: the other depends on the attachments of a few of the leading property in the county to the ministry or opposition of the time being."

If Oldfield's opinion was correct then Lord Craven would have been dominant in selecting Dundas as Craven's lands and influence were in the west of the county.

Reform, or resistance to it, was to be the downfall of the Tories. In 1832 they lost humiliatingly in a general election in which the one issue was the proposed Reform Act. Out of the ashes of the Tory party Robert Peel was to build a new Conservative party, but that is another story.

The Election Starts

The Times reported on June 17

"BERKS. - Mr C Dundas and Mr R Neville again offer for the county. Mr W Hallett again tenders his services as Representative, in pursuance of a promise made at the last General Election [1812]. Mr Hallet supports the principle of Parliamentary reform."

On June 19 a meeting was held in Reading Town Hall to take nominations for the election. In the past this was often the full extent of the election because only two candidates would come forward. In the previous election of 1812 this meeting had

degenerated into a near riot; in 1818 the proceedings appear to have gone more smoothly and the election was called to commence the following week in Abingdon.

The Times article goes on to cover the situation in the Berkshire boroughs:

"READING - On Wednesday, Mr Charles Shaw Lefevre was met at Whitley Turnpike by a great number of the inhabitants of this borough, who took the horse from his carriage, and drew him round the town, preceded by a band of music, and flags bearing various inscriptions: the cheers of the populace were incessant. Mr John Weyland of Hawthorn-hill, contests the honour of representation with Mr C Fyshe Palmer.

WINDSOR, - There is no opposition to the re-election of Colonel Disbrowe and Mr John Ramsbottom.

An opposition is expected at Abingdon to the re-election of Sir G Bowyer. We have not understood that the electors of Wallingford have been successful in the alleged attempt to redeem their independence."

Polling

Polling was a drawn out process, the days of nipping down to the local church hall or school to cast your vote on an election Thursday would not arrive for some time yet.

There was only one place to vote, Abingdon, the traditional county town was still the site of the poll booths, although overshadowed and largely replaced in the role by Reading. Polling took place from June 25th to July 11th (closed on Sundays).

Squibs

Throughout the election pamphlets or handbills known as 'squibs' were distributed exhorting the supporters of one candidate or another to cast their vote.

To many of those entitled to vote the trip need to travel Abingdon would be enough to dissuade them from using their vote. So a major theme of election material from both sides was the call to vote - such as this one printed in Newbury:

SHAME!

To the Friends of Mr. Dundas and Mr. Neville!

GENTLEMEN, are you all asleep! I never thought you would have been so reluctant in coming forward to support the cause you have professed so nobly to espouse.

I have been waiting with carriages of all descriptions ever since 5 o'clock this morning! but (to your shame be it spoken) not a single individual has come forward to accompany me except a worthy *Parson!!!* Rally, boys! Rally!! - Then the day is *ours!!* Other wise *our cause is lost!* AMICUS PATRIÆ

N.B. Chaises are now waiting at Speenhamland, to convey ALL of you who feel inclined to hasten to the Poll; and should there not be sufficient carriages of this description, two *Hearses* with the tops taken off are comfortably seated for your better accommodation, AT MY OWN EXPENSE!

and this one from the same day:

FREEHOLDERS of Berkshire, are you all dead? I clearly perceive that neither Example no Precept will work any effort on your shallow understandings. What do you expect Me to do for you - Nay, what is I have not done for you? Have I not fought your Battles manfully without any other remuneration than a trifling sum of £300 per annum? Have I not continually been maintaining your Independence, by influencing Votes in favour of those who will strenuously support Taxation, Popery and all other things which

(you must know) is in direct *opposition* to the sentiments of those Vile *Dogs*, who call themselves *Reformers*! - Have I not won over *Divinity itself* to our cause, and actually prevailed on the *Reverend Divine* to forego the duties of his Parish in support of it!

AROUSE from your lethargy! Follow the example of so staunch a friend. Never mind duties or the care of souls! - Lose no time in hastening to the Poll, and Vote for NEVVILLE AND DUNDAS! or our cause is lost!! AMICUS PATRIÆ.

N.B. I wish it to be understood, that although a *chosen few* went to the Poll in a *Banker's carriage*, you are not *all* to expect that privilege, as the vehicles I have already announced are still waiting *to convey you*, *AT MY OWN EXPENSE!*

These clearly show that Neville and Dundas were worried, and that electioneering was not cheap.

As every voter could cast two votes there was particular concern that Hallett would pick up votes from voters who would vote for the local candidate (Dundas or Neville) and for the reform candidate. If everyone did this Hallett would get twice the votes of the others. Meanwhile those voting for Hallett were encouraged not to vote for either of the others, thus increasing the effect of their vote for reform. So there was a concerted effort to persuade people to vote for Neville and Dundas as a pair; this was considered highly reprehensible by Hallett's supporters.

The following squib was published.

A COALITION IS DISGRACEFUL

FREEHOLDERS of Berks! Lose no time, but rally round the Standard of Independence, and, by giving a *Plumper* to W. HALLETT ESQ., convince the World that the Independent Freeholders of Berks will never support a man whose conduct requires another *name* to gain him success.

Let no man hereafter boast of Independence who will not *now* support it.

Observe what they are doing in the North of England in support of their favourite Candidate. - Men of the South, imitate their example!

Extract of a Letter from Appleby of June 29th

"At the first village to which we came, we heard the shout of 'Brougham for ever.' Comparatively, few of the Freeholders set out in Carriages. The great body of those who support Mr. Brougham had determined to walk from Kendal to Appleby on foot, and waited till 5 o'clock, when having collected, they were arranged in a procession led by Mr. Tomson, the Chairman of the Kendal Committee (a man upwards of 70 years of age) with Colours streaming, and Music playing at their head. In this manner they marched a distance of 26 miles, over a hilly, rough, and romantic country, with unabated zeal and enthusiasm, more like a body of people on a pilgrimage, or like the army of Peter the Hermit proceeding to the Holy Land, than a Riotous assemblage of Electors proceeding to the Poll."

Men of Berkshire! Out with your Waggons, Barges, Caravans, Carts, Horses, and even Wheel-Barrows for the aged and infirm!

One blind man has declared, if no one will lead him, he will crawl!!

A long pull, a strong pull, and a pull together! Then success is certain. HALLETT and Independence!

It is hard to determine if these exhortations had an appreciable effect in influencing the voting pattern. Although the majority of voters (1509) did cast their votes for Dundas & Neville as a pair or for Hallett alone (192 voted solely for Dundas or Neville while 147 voted for a combination of Hallett and either Dundas or Neville), this pattern was not a new one and may well have been followed if the squibs had never been printed.

A booklet of these squibs, together with speeches by the candidates and other related material was published soon after the election and makes fascinating reading. A copy is held in Reading Local Studies Library.

The number of freeholders polled, during the Election, was 1,849.

Other Poll Books

Poll books are also available for the Shire elections in 1727, 1768, 1796, 1812, and 1820.

There are also poll books for various parliamentary elections for the borough seats in Abingdon, Reading, Wallingford and Windsor.

A third category of rolls are Burgess Rolls, for the election of municipal officials.

Most are held by the Berkshire Record Office; the best collection of Reading rolls are held by the Reading Local Studies Library.

From 1832 the electoral system changed and electoral rolls were generated annually (excepting the war years 1915-17 & 1940-44). These are lists of those entitled to vote, unlike the poll books that only list those who voted.

Some poll books were generated after 1832 but they have not survived as well as the electoral rolls. The Electoral Registers for Berkshire held by the Berkshire Record Office are sparse for the very early years, 1832 is followed by 1839 (plus a small portion from 1834). However from 1839 very few years are missing.

Berkshire Family History Society has previously published transcripts of the 1812 Poll Book and the 1832 Electoral Roll and will produce more Poll Books and Electoral Rolls on CD in the future.

Organisation of the Poll Book

The Poll Book is sorted alphabetically by Place and Name. However, there are a few instances where the alphabetical ordering is not perfect. In 1818 the principal local governance subdivisions within Berkshire were the Hundreds, these are shown alongside each place name in the book.

There are a few places which do not have a Hundred shown; these are small hamlets where the clerk and/or publisher did not know the location. The following list locates these to their parish:

Chippinghambourne (Chipping Lambourn) - Lambourn

Idston (Idstone) - Ashbury

Isbury (Eastbury) - Lambourn

Kintbury Holt - Kintbury

Sanden Fee - Hungerford

West Court - Finchampstead

Reading

The organisation of Hundreds varied over the years; hence this list from 1812 is not the same as that found in the Domesday Book of 1086. However, it is the same as that used for the census of 1841.

Places

The table below lists all places from the poll book and the hundred in which they are located. In many cases the spellings differ from modern usage; this may reflect contemporary usage or the ignorance of the clerk(s) recording the poll, probably a mix of the two.

Names

The spelling of names in the transcript follows that used in the poll book. Although this is a list of the more affluent commoners in the county, a group that would be accustomed to attaching their names to letters, deeds etc., this does not mean that the spellings herein are accurate. The clerk(s) collecting the names may well mishear or misspell and the typesetter of the poll book could easily compound the problem. A comparison with the poll book for the previous election in 1812 shows many instances of the same freeholder's name being spelt differently. For example John Joys (1812) becomes John Jay (1818), John Irons (1812) becomes John Hyrons (1818) - both examples from Longworth.

Another aspect of the presentation of names in this poll book is that forenames appear reversed when compared to the 1812 poll book. For example Collins William Badcock in Frilford in 1812 changes to William Collins Badcock in 1818.

Errata

A small number of corrections were printed at the front of the roll, these corrections have been made to the transcribed data.

Using the CD

The information on the CD is presented in Adobe Acrobat form and bookmarking has been used to ensure that location of the entry of interest is straightforward. Bookmarks guide the user to the index or transcript and within these further bookmarks speed access to specific areas.

Searching to find a particular entry can readily be accomplished using Acrobat's find feature (Control F or the binoculars icon). All text in this CD is fully searchable in this fashion.

The Index

To aid the user looking for specific individuals, a name index is supplied on this CD. Names are arranged alphabetically by surname and forename. Each entry refers to the page number of the original book on which the name is to be found. These page numbers are shown at the top right of each page of the transcript. They are bookmarked within the Roll every ten pages.

The page can be also be located by typing R followed by the page number and Return (δ) into the page number box in the navigation bar at the bottom of the Acrobat window (see screen shot). Make sure the entire box content is highlighted (as in the screen shot) before typing - clicking on the numbering to the left of the bracketed numbers will select the entire contents.



Within the Index, bookmarks are provided for each letter of the alphabet, which will take the user straight to the index page on which names starting with that letter are first shown.

The Transcript

The transcript shows the Poll Book in the order it is printed, each page of the Roll being reproduced on a page of the transcript. As a result many pages have significant whitespace at the bottom; this does not mean that the transcript for the last place recorded is completed on that page, always check the next page.

Bookmarks (A to Y) are provided to take the user to the first place starting with the bookmark letter.

Places with two word names may be listed in several ways so check all possibilities or use the Acrobat search facility. For example East Ilsley is listed as 'Ilsley, East' in the 'I' section and Church Lambourn as 'Lambourn, Church' in the 'L' section, but Great Coxwell is listed as 'Great Coxwell' in the 'C' section and Sutton Courtney is listed as 'Sutton Courtney' in the 'S' section.

A number of hamlets or sub-divisions of parishes are listed in their own right. If you don't find someone you expect to find in the parish, then consider other places he could be found. For example, someone you believe to come from Sutton Courtney could actually be from Sutton Wick, which has its own listing.

Alongside each entry are three columns headed by D, N & H. Crosses in these columns indicate the votes cast by the individual. D is for Dundas, N for Neville and H for Hallett.
